Director Dean called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Director Dean asked for introductions as there were a few new faces.

Aaron Krikava with Rogue Valley Prescribed Burn Association gave a presentation on a recent Conservation Assistance Program (CAP) grant that the Applegate Partnership Watershed Council (APWC) received from JSWCD. The grant was \$7,000 and was used to purchase equipment that would be used for controlled burning to include drop torches, jerry cans, hand tools, backpack pumps, a 1500-gallon tank, hose lay equipment as well as a slip-on unit with a high-pressure pump. Aaron talked about the importance of controlled burning to prevent wildfire.

Beth Pietrzak, with the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA), gave an update on the Agricultural Water Quality Program. Beth presented some background information, roles of ODA and SWCD's, and talked briefly about the District Capacity grants for 2023-2025. These will be \$193,188.00 over a two-year period. Beth also talked about Ag Water Quality Rules, compliance and investigation, and Site Implementation Areas (SIA).

Paul DeMaggio gave a presentation on the Phillips Ditch Project located in the Applegate as well as gave an update on irrigation reservoir storage around the county.

## A motion by Director Niedermeyer with a second by Director Baratta to approve the May 17th, 2023, meeting minutes with the correction of a capitalization of Chris Van Ness's name passed unanimously.
