## How the process works

You'll work with an integrated, local team to move through a comprehensive, step-by-step approach:

- On-site visit to understand your land and priorities
- Comprehensive eligibility review with support
- Planning tailored to your operational need
- Application assistance and coordination
- Project design with technical and engineering support
- Implementation with guidance from start-to-finish

## Timeline: Plan Ahead

These projects are designed to be done right, which means planning ahead is important:

- 3–6 months for initial consultation and planning
- Applications reviewed annually (November–March)
- Design and approvals can take up to 18 months
- Most projects span more than one year from start to finish

## Why it's worth it

Taking the time upfront helps ensure:

- Projects are designed specifically for your land
- Funding is used effectively
- Improvements deliver long-term benefits
- You see results that last for years to come

## Funding and Eligibility:

Funding may support improvements in:

- Grazing management systems
- Irrigation efficiency upgrades
- Streamside / riparian vegetation management
- Soil health and erosion control in working lands

All projects are focused on improving conditions in or near streams, creeks, and other water resources.

## Funding is competitive and not all projects are selected.

- Project selection depends on project priorities, applicant and land eligibility.
- Applications are reviewed and ranked during the annual funding cycle
- Not all eligible, proposed projects will receive funding
