Technical & planning support from JSWCD

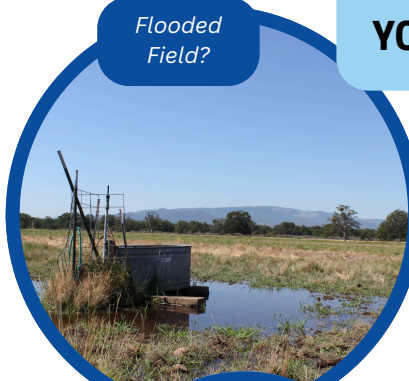
- On-site consultation and assessment

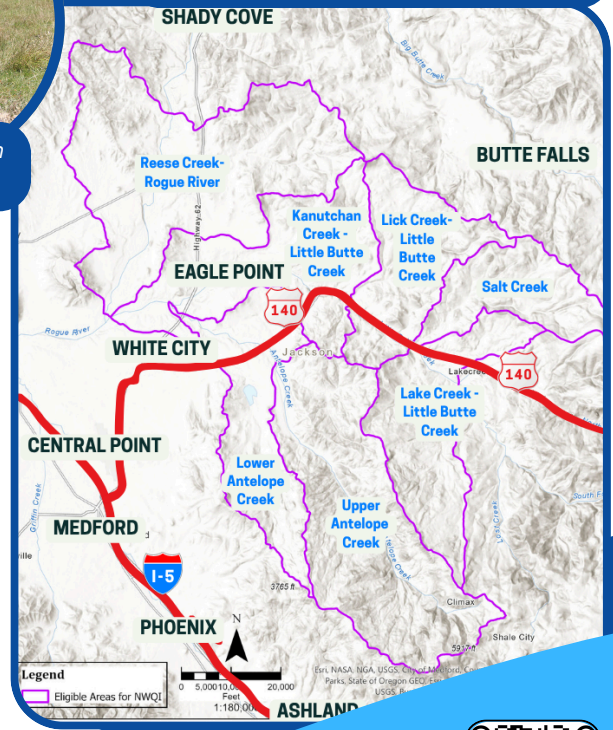
Check the map to see if your land is within the project area - you may be eligible!
